

Parking Brake Inspection and Adjustment

Inspection

1. Parking Brake - Inspect



- 1. Pull the parking brake lever (A) with 200 N (20.4 kgf, 45.0 lbf) of force to fully apply the parking brake.
- 2. The parking brake lever should be locked within the specified number of clicks.


Lever locked clicks: 8 to 10 clicks

3. Adjust the parking brake if the lever clicks are not within the specification.

Adjustment

NOTE: After servicing the rear brake shoes, loosen the parking brake adjusting nut, start the engine, and press the brake pedal several times to set the self-adjusting brake before adjusting the parking brake.

- 1. Vehicle Lift
- 2. Parking Brake Release
- 3. Center Console Remove (Without Center Console Armrest Type)
- 4. Center Console Rear Trim Remove (With Center Console Armrest Type)
- 5. Parking Brake Adjust



This illustration shows with center console armrest type

- 1. Loosen the parking brake adjusting nut (A).
- 2. Pull the parking brake lever 1 click.
- 3. Tighten the adjusting nut until the parking brakes drag slightly when the rear wheels are turned.
- 4. Release the parking brake lever fully.
- 5. Check that the parking brakes do not drag when the rear wheels are turned. Readjust if necessary.
- 6. Make sure the parking brake lever is within the specified number of clicks (8 to 10 clicks).
- 6. Center Console Install (Without Center Console Armrest Type)
- 7. Center Console Rear Trim Install (With Center Console Armrest Type)
